Bill Rumpler

Bill Rumpler (Rump) could play about any position but primarily would play left field and would pitch when nobody else would. Rump played from 1968 to 2004 with Champion Paper, Bob's Café, Imperial Cleaning, Butler County Sheriff's, Hamilton Hurricanes, Case Trucking and was player/coach for Bengel Construction. He was such a good hitter that over the years he was a pick-up player for over 30 different teams for weekend tournaments and he helped win many of those tournaments. Bill's main team was Champion Paper and he played for them from 1973 to 2000. While playing for Champion, in the late 1980s, he helped them win a State Championship by hitting 3 Home Runs in the Final game. Bill was also a member of the Case Trucking Hamilton City Series Championship Team. Rump won several batting titles was All State 3 times, made an All Regional Team and won 3 MVP titles. Bill is proud to be honored today as he joins his dad, Robert Rumpler (Slug), 1984 Hall of Famer, and his uncle Chic Rumpler, 1987 Hall of Famer (both Fastpitch Stars of the 14K Hudepohl Team) to the Butler County Softball Hall of Fame. Bill played for an amazing 36 years.
